PETITION FOR DECLARATORY RULING

Chris Koster, Attorney General of the State of Missouri, joined by the Missouri Broadcasters Association and Zimmer Radio of Mid Missouri Inc. (collectively “Petitioners”) seek a declaratory ruling on a narrow issue: Is Frazier Glenn Miller a “bona fide” candidate for United States Senate who is entitled to mandatory access to Missouri’s broadcast airwaves? Mandatory access is provided only for legally qualified candidates, including certain write-in candidates who are in fact “bona fide candidates.” Petitioners seek clarification from the Federal Communications Commission (“FCC”) on this point. Petitioners file this Petition for Declaratory Ruling pursuant to § 1.2¹ of the FCC’s Rules and § 554(e) of the Administrative Procedure Act.²

Petitioners seek only a determination of whether Miller should be given mandatory access to Missouri broadcasting stations so as to provide certainty to their constituencies. In the case of General Koster, who is the duly elected Attorney General of Missouri, he is charged with the responsibility “to protect the rights and interests of the state, and enforce any and all rights,

interests or claims against any and all persons, firms, or corporations in whatever court or jurisdiction such action may be necessary.”³ General Koster, therefore, appears before the Commission in his capacity to represent the public interest on behalf of all the citizens and broadcasters of Missouri, and to seek certainty regarding which candidates qualify for access to Missouri’s airwaves.⁴

The Missouri Broadcasters Association (the “MBA”) joins with General Koster in this Petition. The MBA is an association whose members comprise substantially all of the radio and television stations licensed by the Commission in the State of Missouri, and therefore the parties that must honor access demands under § 312(a)(7) and who would be liable for programming matter that does not enjoy the immunity protections of § 315(a) of the Communications Act of 1934 (the “Act”). Zimmer Radio of Mid Missouri Inc. (“Zimmer”) also joins with General Koster. Zimmer has been in the radio broadcasting business in Missouri since 1956 and presently operates nine radio broadcasting stations in three markets, all allocated to communities in the State of Missouri, reaching listeners throughout most of the State. The group is headquartered in Columbia, Missouri.

Petitioners request a ruling to establish whether an alleged write-in candidate for United States Senate from Missouri, in this case Frazier Glenn Miller, a/k/a Glenn Miller, has met the requirements of § 312(a)(7) of the Communications Act and FCC Rule § 73.1940 to be afforded the privilege of mandatory access.

I. BACKGROUND

In recent weeks multiple Missouri broadcasting stations have received demands for mandatory access by Glenn Miller, who claims to be a legally qualified write-in candidate for United States Senate from Missouri. In this capacity, he has demanded access to various Missouri broadcast stations, including those owned and licensed to Zimmer and other members of the MBA, to air certain radio spots associated with his purported candidacy. Audio files of these messages are enclosed, along with transcripts, as Attachment “A” hereto.

FCC rules require that “legally qualified candidates” for Federal elective office be granted reasonable access to broadcasting stations.⁵ Advertisements of a “legally qualified candidate” are to be aired without change, regardless of normal suitability standards, because “such licensee shall have no power of censorship over the material broadcast” by the candidate.⁶ Accordingly, if a person is a “legally qualified candidate” for federal elective office and makes a “use” of a broadcast station, their message may not be censored by the broadcasting station and the candidate may use the time as he or she sees fit.

Since the licensee is denied the power of censorship in the area of such political broadcasting, it follows as a corollary that “the mandate prohibiting censorship includes the privilege of immunity from liability for defamatory statements made by the speaker.”⁷ However, if a station grants access to a speaker who does not meet the requirements of a “legally qualified candidate,” and in the case of a write-in candidate, a *bona fide* candidate, as provided for in § 315(a) of the Act, the station could be liable for the tortuous conduct of the speaker.

As the representative of the State of Missouri and its citizenry, General Koster seeks this declaratory relief to provide certainty and resolution for Missouri citizens regarding who qualifies as a “bona fide” candidate entitled to mandatory access to Missouri’s airwaves. The MBA, in turn, represents Missouri radio and television stations. The MBA appears before the Commission seeking a determination under § 315(a) and §312(a)(7) of the Act on behalf of its member Missouri broadcasting stations, who desire to have the legal uncertainty resolved so that they may avoid legal liability for these ads, if they are required to be broadcast, or so that they may apply their normal suitability standards to the subject messages if they are not required to be broadcast under the Act. Zimmer Radio of Mid Missouri Inc. seeks a determination that applies to it as licensee of stations that are the subject of specific demands from Glenn Miller. So that MBA member broadcast stations may comply with Federal law and FCC rules, and so that the citizens of Missouri will understand the reasons for which Miller’s messages are being broadcast to them -- if indeed such is required -- the Petitioners respectfully request a determination by the Federal Communications Commission whether Miller is a “*bona fide*” candidate for the United States Senate from Missouri at this time, and if not now, when he might be so considered.

II. ACCESS RIGHTS

Access rights under § 312(a)(7) are available only to legally qualified candidates for Federal elective office. Section 73.1940 of the FCC rules set out a three-part test for determining whether a person is a “legally qualified candidate.” The test requires that the candidate:

1. has publicly announced his or her intention to run for nomination or office;
2. is qualified under the applicable local, state or federal law to hold the office for which he or she is a candidate; and
3. has met one of the following further qualifications:

- a. qualified for a place on the ballot, or
- b. publicly committed to seeking election by the write-in method and made a substantial showing that he or she is a *bona fide* candidate.⁸

Miller claims the status of write-in candidate for United States Senate from Missouri. He has filed his declaration of intent to be a write-in candidate.⁹ Under that statute, votes for him can be counted, although he may be elected only if he receives a separate plurality of the votes without party designation. Miller's declaration of intent does not indicate whether he meets all of the requirements of Art. I, § 3 of the United States Constitution to hold the office of United States Senator; being at least 30 years old, a citizen of the United States for at least nine years, and an inhabitant of the State of Missouri.¹⁰ Miller must also meet two other requirements:

- i. a public commitment to seek election, and
- ii. a substantial showing that he is a *bona fide* candidate.

A. Public Commitment

The public commitment component requires that the would-be candidate demonstrate a present commitment to seek election. However, Miller has made statements on a message board – VNN.org – that indicate he is treating the election season as a way to make broadcasters carry his messages rather than a legitimate opportunity to seek public office, and that at the time he was seeking to have his messages placed on radio stations he had not made up his mind whether to actually run. *See* Attachment “B” containing the following statements:

Federal elections offer public speaking opportunities we can't afford to pass up, and only come every 2 years.

* * *

So who'll pledge financial support here and now, so I can decide whether or not to run ?? And say how much.

All governmental privileges must be guarded so that they are not misused. For example, the privilege from the antitrust laws for political petitioning activities, recognized in *Eastern Railroad Presidents Conference v. Noerr Motor Freight, Inc.*¹¹, does not apply if the political activity at issue was “a mere sham to cover what is actually nothing more than an attempt to interfere directly with the business relationships of a competitor.” *Id.* at 144. Similarly, the normal privilege from defamation liability that applies to legal pleadings does not apply to sham filings, made solely to cloak defamatory statements in the privilege. *Oregon Natural Resources Council v. Mohla*, 944 F.2d 531, 534-35 (9th Cir. 1991) (explaining the application of the sham exception to the filing of lawsuits); *see also Primetime 24 Joint Venture v. National Broadcasting Co.*, 28 Med.L.Rptr. 1993 (2d Cir. 2000) (defendant had no antitrust privilege when it made sham use of Satellite Home Viewer Act). Hence, a privilege or right granted by law does not apply where someone attempts to make use of that privilege for purposes beyond its intended scope. Just as one may not avail himself or herself of the *Noerr* privilege if he or she is not engaged in genuine political petitioning, or the judicial activity privilege if he or she is misusing litigation as a tool for defamation, the special rights of § 312(a)(7) should not be available for someone who is not a *bona fide* candidate, who seeks to misuse that statute to

broadcast non-campaign messages. Congress did not enact § 312(a)(7) to provide “can’t afford to pass up” opportunities for anyone to broadcast non-campaign messages; rather, Congress limited the special rights of that section only to opportunities for *bona fide* political advertising by *bona fide* candidates.

A cursory reading of the commercial copy provided in Attachment “A” demonstrates that whatever Miller’s commitment might be, it is not about getting elected in the general election, but simply to pervert the campaign laws found in the Communications Act to his true purpose of requiring FCC licensees to broadcast his non-campaign messages to an unsuspecting public.

B. Substantial Showing

An individual seeking to qualify as a write-in candidate bears the burden to make a “substantial showing” that he is a *bona fide* candidate for office. To make the substantial showing of *bona fide* candidacy, the claimed write-in candidate must engage to a substantial degree in activities commonly associated with political campaigning.¹² “Such activities normally would include making campaign speeches, distributing campaign literature, issuing press releases, maintaining a campaign committee, and establishing campaign headquarters.”¹³ The Commission has held that when seeking a statewide office, such as United States Senator, these activities must have occurred sufficiently across the state to demonstrate a statewide presence.¹⁴

The burden is on the individual to establish to the stations from which the individual seeks to obtain time under § 312 that that individual has “engaged to a substantial degree in

activities commonly associated with political campaigning.”¹⁵ Moreover, the alleged write-in candidate must supply specific information regarding the statewide campaign activities he or she has engaged in, and will not have carried the substantial showing burden by furnishing mere conclusions.¹⁶ Certain Missouri Broadcasters Association members have requested materials from Miller substantiating his claim of *bona fide* statewide candidacy. See Attachment “C.” Miller initially simply made demands upon the stations based upon his conclusory statement that he has qualified as a write-in candidate.¹⁷ His statements in Attachment “C” indicate that Miller believes he is entitled to access merely by filing his declaration of intent to become a write-in candidate, that he is unaware of the requirement to engage in a *bona fide* campaign and that he has not conducted any of the campaign activities normally associated with *bona fide* political activity. Moreover, as shown above, it is not even clear that Miller is a candidate at this time. He has requested funds from his supporters so that “he can decide whether or not to run.”

The applicable regulations make it clear that a purported candidate can only meet his “substantial showing” burden for proving the *bona fides* of his candidacy with clear objective evidence. A candidate may not prove his or her *bona fides* through mere professions of intent to act as a candidate, mere speculation about what others may be doing, and mere hopes that a corps of dedicated supporters will spring into action in the future.¹⁸

On two recent occasions, Miller was asked to explain the basis for his claim that he is a *bona fide* candidate. See Attachments “D” and “E” (email from Beth Davis of Clear Channel, and letter from Mark Sableman, Missouri counsel for the Missouri Broadcasters Association). His response to both inquiries was a letter, setting forth what he claims is the “full factual basis” for his claim that he is a *bona fide* candidate for United States Senate. Attachments “F” & “G.” While the letter contained a 14-point list, many of the items on the list are clearly irrelevant to the *bona fides* of the purported candidacy. For example, Miller listed as several of the facts supporting his *bona fides*, his family history and his military service; these facts have no bearing on whether he has established a *bona fide* candidacy. Attachment “G”, items 2 & 3. He also listed facts about his qualifications for office and declaration of intent to run, which are different issues (covered by § 73.1940((a)(1) & (2), not § 73.1940(f) of the Commission’s rules). Attachment “G”, items 1 & 14.

Miller’s letter then attempts to portray an active candidacy, based on essentially the following activities:

- his posting of a website (containing a printable flyer, which he speculates some supporters may have printed out) (Attachment “G”, items 7, 8 & 10)
- his running of 77 radio commercials in inexpensive late-night time slots (Attachment “G”, items 5 & 6)
- three speeches “at three separate gatherings of my supporters” (*i.e.*, apparently not public speeches to outsiders) with no further specifics of location, time or number of audience members; (Attachment “G”, item 9)
- eight radio talk show appearances, without any specifics indicating discussion of candidacy (Attachment “G”, items 6 & 8)
- a single sign on a single truck, which he intends to, but has not yet driven around the state (Attachment “G”, item 11)

- his expectations, hopes and speculation as to newspaper ads, speeches, and joint appearances with other candidates (Attachment “G”, items 12 & 13)

Essentially, Miller has created a website (like millions of other persons), he has purchased some inexpensive late-night radio commercials (of which the transcripts and audio files are attached; see Attachment “A”), he has talked to a few supporters, he has a single sign, and he hopes that legitimate campaign opportunities such as joint appearances may develop. This is not a “substantial showing” of a *bona fide* candidacy. It contains none of the objective criteria mentioned in § 73.1940, such as a campaign committee, a campaign headquarters, campaign offices (particularly relevant for a statewide Senate campaign), press releases, or true campaign speeches (*i.e.*, to the public). The lack of anything in Miller’s “full factual basis” meeting the prescribed objective criteria is telling.

Indeed, as an example of the inadequacy of his showing, the single campaign sign as featured on Mr. Miller’s website appears to be a generic campaign sign perhaps left over from a previous campaign. See Attachment “H” (whty.com website pages showing sign). It does not mention the Senate seat for which he is allegedly running. (It mentions “U.S. Congress,” only, which is usually taken as a reference to the House of Representatives, for which Mr. Miller claimed to be a write-in candidate some years ago.) It does not mention the state, Missouri, in which he is allegedly running. Its website reference is not to the campaign website. Its telephone number does not include an area code, even though Missouri is served by multiple area codes. Nothing about the sign suggests a legitimate 2010 candidacy for Missouri’s open Senate seat.

Similarly, while Miller claims his appearance on talk shows as evidence of a bona fide candidacy, he appears to devote little or no time during those interviews to discussion of his purported candidacy. *See* Attachment “I,” linking to his interview on the Howard Stern show.

Miller’s submission relies almost entirely on previously aired commercials, and the publicity attendant to them. *See* Attachment “G”, items 5-8. Yet those commercials were run only because, at the time, the stations assumed and believed, based on Miller’s claims, that § 312(a)(7) required them to run such commercials. If indeed, as now appears, Miller does not have a *bona fide* candidacy, the stations could have and would have rejected those commercials. Commercials aired in the mistaken belief that the candidate qualified under § 312(a)(7) can hardly be evidence of the required *bona fide* candidacy. It would be circular logic in the extreme to use commercials that the stations thought were compelled by law, but which were not, as evidence of a *bona fide* candidacy, thereby creating the legal compulsion they seek by this petition to avoid.

III. COMMENCEMENT OF GENERAL ELECTION

Finally, it is legitimate to question whether the campaign for general election has actually begun and whether a candidate for the general election, who is not required to participate in the primary election, could support a claim for access rights at this time. There are eleven candidates vying for nomination in the Missouri primary election. All of these other candidates must first be vetted through a primary process that is not concluded and is still two months off. In *Carter-Mondale*,¹⁹ the Supreme Court recognized the question of whether it was too early to accept political advertising for a specific election to be a legitimate inquiry.

The FCC's practice of independently determining – by examining objective evidence and considering the position of both the candidate and the networks, as well as other factors – whether a campaign has begun and the obligations imposed by the statute have attached does not improperly involve the FCC in an electoral process or significantly impair broadcasters' editorial discretion.

Based upon records found on the website of the Federal Election Commission ("FEC"), seven candidates who are seeking nomination in the Missouri primaries for their party's right to be the candidate for United States Senate have filed financial reports. Financial reports are required when any candidate either raises or spends \$5,000 or more.²⁰ Miller has not filed such a report and, therefore, one might assume that he has not raised or spent \$5,000. However, seven candidates have done so and must be vetted through the primary process.

At this point, it is unknown who the candidates will be in the general election three months following the primary election. Since Miller has no opponent in the primary season as a supposed write-in candidate, and had not raised sufficient funds in the last reporting period to have had to file with the FEC, it is reasonable to assume that the campaign season for which he claims to be a "legally qualified candidate" has not yet commenced. Furthermore, from the nature of the spots he seeks to place, the websites to which listeners are referred, and his statements in Attachments "C" and "G", it is questionable whether the purpose of his spots are campaign messages seeking election support or merely vehicles to convey Miller's message. Accordingly, the Petitioners seek the determination by the Federal Communications Commission that the general election for alleged write-in candidates in Missouri for United States Senate has not yet begun.

CONCLUSION

Accordingly, Petitioners seek a declaratory ruling from the FCC whether Frazier Glenn Miller is a “legally qualified candidate” for United States Senate from Missouri, whether he has established a *bona fide* write-in candidacy, and whether the campaign for general election has actually begun. The FCC’s determination will provide certainty to Missouri citizens and broadcasters within the state.

Dear Attorney General Koster:

I am writing to you on behalf of the Missouri Broadcasters Association ("MBA").

Several of its member broadcasters have recently been contacted by Frazier Miller, who claims to be a legally qualified write-in candidate for U.S. Senate. In this capacity, he has demanded access at Missouri broadcast stations to air certain radio advertisements associated with his candidacy. Audio files of the advertisements are enclosed, along with transcripts.

The advertisements do not meet the suitability standards of the broadcasters, so the broadcasters would not normally air these advertisements. However, federal law and Federal Communications Commission ("FCC") rules require that advertisements of a "legally qualified candidate" be aired without change, regardless of normal suitability standards. 47 U.S.C. § 312(a)(7). A "legally qualified candidate for public office" is any person who, among other things, "is qualified under the applicable local, State or Federal law to hold the office for which he or she is a candidate." 47 C.F.R. § 73.1940. While Mr. Miller claims to have completed and filed the documents necessary to qualify as a write-in candidate under Missouri law, the FCC defers to state law and the determination of the state official who has authority to decide whether a candidate is a legally qualified candidate, including meeting the state's age, residency and other requirements of applicable law to hold the office sought, and when in the application process someone who is legally qualified becomes a candidate for the office being sought.

So that MBA member broadcast stations may comply with federal law and FCC rules, the MBA respectfully requests a determination, by the state official that has the authority to decide, as to whether Mr. Miller is a "legally qualified candidate" for U.S. Senate under Missouri law at this time, and if not now, when he would be so considered. Your determination will inform

Missouri broadcast stations in their decision regarding whether they have an obligation to broadcast the enclosed advertisements.

Additionally, there is some uncertainty as to Mr. Miller's name. The enclosed advertisements identify the candidate as Glenn Miller, but his dealings with Missouri broadcasters indicate that he also uses the name Frazier Miller in connection with his political campaign. Thus, we also respectfully request a determination whether Glenn Miller or Frazier Miller, if either, is a the "legally qualified candidate." In addition, we seek a determination whether a candidate must be legally qualified under his legal name or whether a nickname or pseudonym may be used.

Finally, we respectfully request that you advise us when the Missouri general election campaign for the U.S. Senate seat is deemed to begin, and whether it may begin prior to the conclusion of the primary elections.

Thank you in advance for your consideration of these matters.


